Margaret's Pumpkin Soup



INGREDIENTS:

- 1/4 medium pumpkin
- Small orange sweet potato peeled
- 1 finely diced medium onion
- 1 garlic clove (optional)
- Nutmeg & salt to taste
- 1 tablespoon Vegeta powder stock

METHOD:

- Cut pumpkin and sweet potato into thin slices (leave skin on pumpkin)
- Bake in hot oven until cooked with a bit of colour.
- Place in large saucepan with dices onion and cover with water. Add sprinkle of nutmeg and Vegeta stock to the pot and boil for 10 minutes.
- Blend until smooth and serve.
